CAR PARKING

When you arrive and drive into the car park at Jimmy's Farm & Wildlife Park it will look like this.

Our bouncy castle will be located either side of the tent.



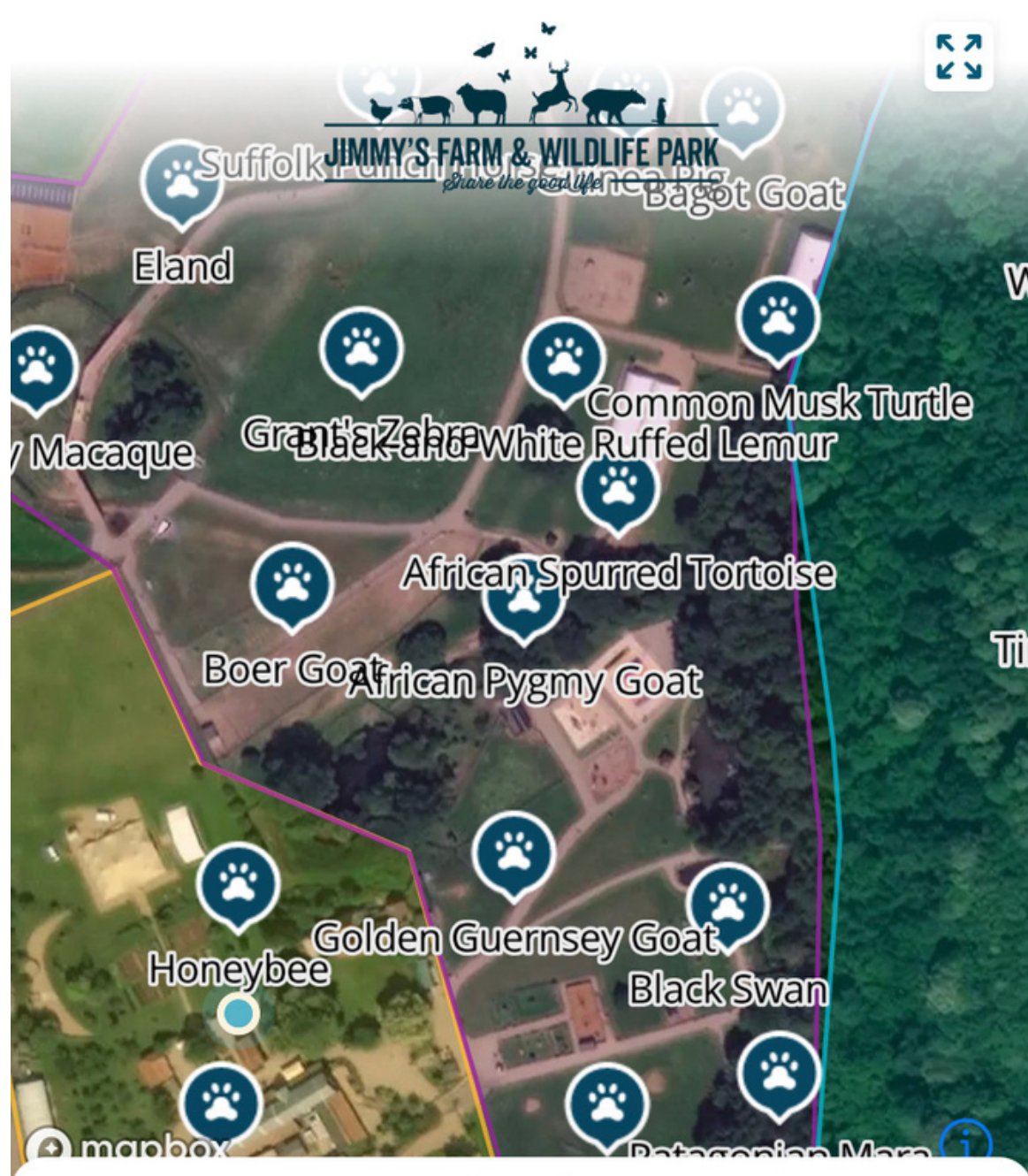
We have some wonderful traditional rides and games for all ages;

FOOD & DRINK

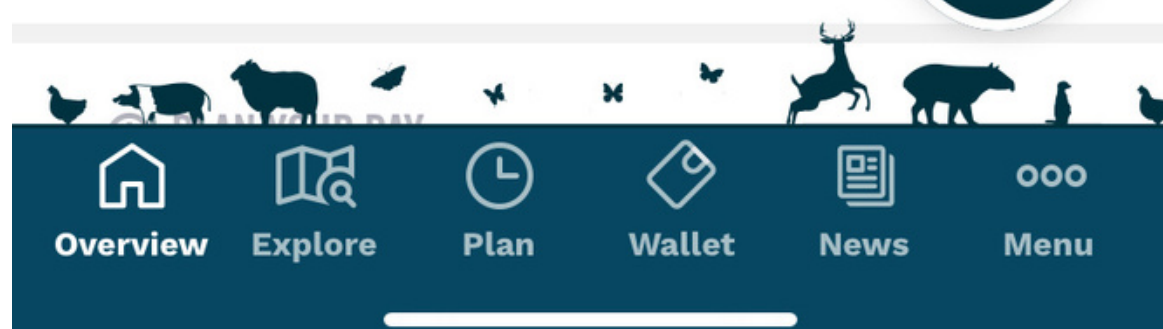
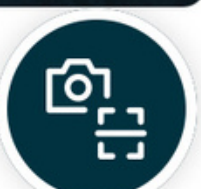
There will be food and drink available from different caterers at the event. All the food will be takeaway only.

TOILETS

There will be a disabled friendly toilet next to the breakout space mentioned on the next page. There is also a disabled toilet (with baby changing) in the restaurant.

The restaurant has men and women's toilets.

You will also find toilets near the Joules shop, on the corner.

Please be aware that we have both hot air hand dryers and paper towels in the toilets.

When on the car parking field, where the fireworks are going off, there will be portaloos.



BREAKOUT SPACE

We are providing a breakout space for those of you who wish to enjoy the event but need some time out from the crowds and lights. We are keeping the area calm and settled, there will plenty of room to have a run around as well as a quiet indoor space to sit and chillout. Members of the team from Autism & ADHD will be there to support if needed.



To access the breakout zone you will need to go through the doors of this building (image on the left) in the courtyard.

Once you have entered via the doors of the building above you will walk out into an area that looks like the image on the right. That round house is where the breakout zone will be.





LOW-BANG FIREWORKS

At around 6:30pm, someone will announce on a speaker that the fireworks are about to begin and ask people to walk back to the field they parked in. The fireworks will be accompanied by Disney music and will last for 15 minutes.



If you have parked in our Autism and ADHD parking zone you can watch the fireworks from your car, if you would like.



AFTER THE FIREWORKS

After the fireworks have finished, at roughly 7pm, you can either leave via the field you are parked on or head back into the event. Car parking marshalls wearing high vis will be located by the exit points.

The event finishes at 8pm and everyone will leave at this point.
